- **Event Coordination**: Organize and assist with beer festivals, food pairings, golf course tastings, and other promotional events throughout Cape Breton Island.
- **Customer Engagement**: Engage with customers in the taproom, at events, and through deliveries, providing a positive and informative experience.

Packaging & Production Support

- **Packaging Line**: Work as part of the team on our rotary automatic canning line, including packaging, labeling, and palletizing finished products.
- **Keg Handling**: Clean, fill, and prepare kegs for delivery, ensuring the highest standards of quality and cleanliness.
- **Warehouse Operations**: Stock and organize the warehouse, ensuring products are properly stored and accessible for orders and deliveries.
- **General Brewery Sanitation**: Assist with general cleaning and sanitation tasks in both the brewery and taproom, ensuring a safe and clean working environment.
